Call to Order/Introductions/Approval of Minutes

Tony Helbling called meeting to order. Everyone in attendance introduced themselves. Quorum present to approve past minutes. Tony Helbling motioned, Jim Hand moved, Bruce Bennett seconded, all in favor, passed unanimously.

Membership Committee: Joe Montesano-LFN Membership renewals are in June working on updating memberships.

Airport Safety Committee: Bruce Bennett- Noise meeting with Tower will recap during this meeting.

Noise Committee: Nick Kaiser had meeting with Tower, Raul and John to explain.

Public Relations: Kevin O'malley-Nothing New, please email with legislature questions.

Kevin Cameron-Lake this morning is at 102%, last night 104%, pouring water out of big cliff now at about 8500 cubic feet per second.

1. Down to two candidates for our Economic Development Coordinator, new position that we are adding to Marion County in our Community Services Department. Whoever gets position will bring to PAAM meeting for introduction and updates on projects.
2. Had meeting in St. Paul about a month ago with Sheriff Department and Public Works Department, Commander Hlad with news regarding North county traffic issues. PAAM individuals please continue to show up to these meeting as were handed a Petition with approximately 500 signatures, basically came from people west of freeway saying to stop all economic growth in North Marion County until certain traffic issues are dealt with and they stopped their issues on I-5.

We are going to continue to do these meetings an inside schedule with Sheriff Department and Public Works Department (another meeting probably in October 2017). Airport road has real issues, 551 intersections. Hubbard is looking into contracting with Sheriff Department. There will be a presentation at the Hubbard Council meeting, urge all to attend. This contracting would be a positive for KUAO.

Aurora already does contract with Sheriff Department.

Don Parise-Marion County Sheriff Department-Nothing new, Emailed out suspect photos from the Hubbard storage theft. Last seen in Sandy area, (Clackamas county) and hit as far south as Jefferson. Car has Colorado plates. Will follow up if any new information/status regarding the suspect.

Rod Yoder-Fire district is working with the state of Oregon to do a airport fire fighter class here KUAO. We now have a person that is certified to train. There will be NO cost for the class, however we still do not have a facility anywhere in

Oregon to do a live actual fire. So will have to go to out of state for the live fire. Last time Columbia Helicopters helped out with this, and in turn we had a cooperative agreement to stand by when they were testing Moroccan helicopters. We will be on our own this time for the live fire costs and will probably send 5 fireman to Utah, where we would have to pay for airfare and a one day class. We are looking for any financial help available. This certified class is done every 2 years at a certified facility, and the off year can do at PDX/Portland. Once we have this class we can certify ourselves therefore certified to teach.

Tim our training officer has this worked up the specifics and I will forward the information to Tony for circulation with PAAM, KUAO, and others.

Need information on **every** water districts for ISO. ISO is a rating bureau which sets the insurance class for each fire district. Can have a direct effect on insurance rates, in lots of cases water districts rates have gone down. Aurora fire District is doing the actual testing at no charge.

Ted Millar to Rod Yoder-Had some tenants inquiring about fire extinguisher training anything available?

Rod Yoder-Aurora Fire District has classes through the public outreach. Call Bill at Aurora Fire and something can be set up. Our setup is digital simulator so it is not shooting actual fire extinguisher agent. We do not have simulator for foam and not certain if there is an actual class at this time. Will look into a little deeper regarding the foam.

Oregon Department of Aviation-John Wilson

- Please be cautious as State airports will be under going spring mowing, will be on the road for the next 6 months.
- August 4th 2017 slated to have the lines put at the tower in for ADIS. Window about 30 days before up and running after August 4th, 2017.

- November 2017 start the install of radar system and then sometime after that it will be up and running. Will be getting ours when PDX gets updated. Will keep informed.
- Line Painting/stripping completion-waiting for weather to improve, will give as much warning as possible, requesting to complete in night hours.
- Run up North end 17 and everything on your list in past meeting is on the on our CIP list, however, still have vehicle/pedestrian deviations to deal with and the above progress is dependent on the infractions of which the FAA is concerned about. Timing/engineering and ability to prevent deviations are all factors.

New Business-Brian Stubbs-HAA Nothing new. Good weather is on the way, be aware of increased traffic West of Hillsboro and be on radios. Actively seeking other places, looking at North of Mexico, South of Canada and West of the Rockies for another flight school to help reduce traffic congestion.

-The Tower is expecting to have RADAR operational summer of 2018 (June?)

-Held a Noise meeting with community members a few days ago and a couple of pilot expressing concerns and was very productive. Talked about trying to keep most traffic for 17 to west side. Will try to have a meeting every 3 to 4 months and try to have TRACON be in attendance as well to further address additional requests/problems.

-Will have a meeting with Portland TRACON in reference to the Noise sensitive area around Aurora State and addressed other operational concerns

-Pilot Weather Reports (PIREPs) are now a requirement for Air Traffic to request or deliver weather reports when conditions warrant.

-Will be working with pilots that are transient or not letting them know by fliers, the development 3 miles north of the airport (Charbonneau) and community 2 miles SE (Aurora) of KUAO as not everyone knows the outer lying communities affected by air traffic.
